Staging Procedures

Most members have already experienced our "Staging Procedures" when we meet for our rides. It can sometimes be a bit confusing so here is an overview of the process. This will also give our new members an idea of what to expect at staging time.

All scheduled, sanctioned CNS rides depart from Texan Harley-Davidson (unless notified otherwise). If the ride is scheduled at leave at 8 AM, plan your arrival for 7:30 or at least thirty minutes before the scheduled departure. This allows Road Captains the necessary time to get registered and assemble their groups together. When the departure time is posted, that means "LAST BIKE OUT" at that time. It is important that you have a full tank of gas, empty bladder and be ready to ride.

Upon arrival, find a temporary parking spot away from the main drive-through area. Road Captains park on the north side of the parking lot (next to the building) and all other riders should back their motorcycles in along the south fenced area of the parking lot. There are signs posted accordingly. The objective is to keep the main driveway clear. This area will be used by the Road Captains to assemble the groups.

Go to the registration table and present your CNS membership card. If you do not have your CNS membership card with you, you must sign a [Chapter Event Release Form](#) to participate on the ride. If you have a guest who is not a member, they must sign a release form to participate on the ride. If a minor is riding, you or the parent/guardian must also sign an additional [Chapter Event Release Form for Minors](#) and possibly a [Minor's Assumption of Risk Acknowledgement](#). Please do not feel that you are being singled out to sign release forms. This is a requirement by H.O.G. Chapter Guidelines for insurance purposes. Chapter Officers have to follow these procedures if they do not have their cards with them. Help the Road Captain by coming to them and letting them know that you are available to ride in his or her group. You do not have to wait for them to come to you. This is where we really need your help to save a lot of time and confusion. We will try to keep the number of bikes to approximately eight per group.

Sometimes, you may not have the time to review the route or other details in the parking lot of Texan. Just be patient, and the Road Captain will find a place down the road to explain the route and procedures. Then, you will be on your way for an enjoyable and fun ride with your fellow Shooters and friends.
